**Doctors of the Church: 15/37 St Peter Damian 1007-1072** Feast day 21 February. Born in Ravenna, orphaned

when young, he was left in the charge of a brother in whose house he was treated more like a slave than family. He joined a community of hermits, and was essentially a reformer, both as a monk and later as Cardinal Bishop of Ostia. He was called a Doctor of the Church by Pope Leo XII without previous canonisation. He is one of those stern figures who seem specially raised up, like St. John the Baptist, to recall men in a lax age from the error of their ways and to bring them back into the narrow path of virtue. His onslaught on clerical behaviour is called the Gomorrah Book' he even asked them not to play chess! "Strengthen your patience with understanding, and look forward serenely to the joy that comes after sadness."
